ABOUT UTKARSH BANGLA EXCELLENCE AWARDS



ABOUT UTKARSH BANGLA EXCELLENCE AWARDS

Government of West Bengal is committed towards large scale skill development for its youth population to improve the scope of gainful employment and entrepreneurial opportunities under the West Bengal Skill Development Mission (WBSDM) chaired by the Hon'ble Chief Minister of West Bengal. To ensure that the above commitment is met successfully the Department of Technical Education, Training & Skill Development; Government of West Bengal, launched the "Utkarsh Bangla", a flagship scheme on 16th February 2016.

Since 2011, this vision of the Hon'ble Chief Minister has guided the TETSD Department to expand the technical and vocational education and skilling opportunities, ensuring affordability and access across demographies. The number of Polytechnics have increased 5 times and there has been a three fold increase in seat capacity. With a target of one ITI per block, the number of ITIs and the capacity intake has increased 4 times the figure of 2011. The intake capacity of vocational studies have also doubled during the period. The Short Term Training has seen a paradigm shift from supply driven to industry demand driven employment linked training since 2021. Out of the 1500 approved industry partners, 900 industries are already training candidates as per industry needs.

The technically trained and skilled youths of West Bengal have been consistently winning awards at national and international level for their proficiency in skills in various National Level Skill Competition and World Skill Competition. ITI students are securing all India ranks from 2020. Total 48 ITI students have been declared all India top rankers since 2020-2024. In the last three years 4 Instructors have been identified for the National Teachers' Award. Youths of the state have been participating in the National Skills and World Skills Competition since 2020-2021. In 2020-2021 the youths participated in 10 Skill Streams in both National Skills and World Skills Competition and won 1 Gold Medal, 1 Silver Medal and 1 Bronze Medal. In 2023-2024 the candidates participated in 23 Skills Streams and won 3 Gold Medals and 1 Bronze Medal at National Level and 2 Medallions of Excellence in World Skills Competition.

These awards and recognitions won at national and international arena were also recognised at the state level and has given a huge fillip to the skilling eco system. The

students are making active choices to join the Polytechnic and ITI courses and are also considering Vocational Courses as a career option.

The **Utkarsh Bangla Excellence Awards** initiated in 2025, is meant to institutionalize the recognition of the dedication and commitment of the Teachers/Trainers/Training Providers and Students and Trainees.

The *Utkarsh Bangla State Skill Competition*, a part of the Utkarsh Bangla Excellence Awards, was also initiated in 2025 in alignment with World Skill Competition to encourage the talent already existing among the youths of the state, to identify the skill strength early and to mentor and hone these candidates for better performance in the national and international level skill competitions.

The Utkarsh Bangla Excellence Awards recognises the contribution made by Teachers/ Trainers and Training Providers and the accolades won by the students and trainees in their education and skills across the following segments

- 1. Best technical Teacher/Instructor- Polytechnics
- 2. Best Skill Trainers in Government ITI/PPP ITI (Engineering and Non Engineering Trades)
- 3. Best Vocational Teachers (State funded VTCs and CSS-VSE) for Both Engineering and Non-Engineering Course
- 4. Best trainer- i) Industry Led Model ii) Letter of Intent based Model.
- 5. Topper of Toppers 5 rankers in Polytechnic
- 6. National Toppers of All India Trade Test
- 7. Five Top rankers in HS Vocational
- 8. National Awardees and State Skill/Training Competition Toppers

BEST LECTURER IN GOVERNMENT POLYTECHNICS



Sri Tanmoy Dey, Lecturer in Electrical Engineering at Jalpaiguri Polytechnic Institute, holds a B. Tech from Jalpaiguri Government Engineering College and an M.E. from IIEST Shibpur. He started his career as Technical Consultant in PWC for 3 years and then joined the diploma education. Sri Dey has demonstrated excellent teaching-learning skills in the last 7 years contributing to curriculum development, online learning resources, accreditation work etc. He has mentored students in innovative projects like solar EV charging systems, Arduino-based home automation, and fiber-optic motor control. His guidance has led to placements of students in top government and private organizations, including Indian Railways, WBSEDCL, Power Grid, Tata Consultancy Engineering, L&T etc.

His research contributions include publications in reputed platforms, such as the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers (IEEE) International Conference on Control, Instrumentation, Energy & Communication (CIEC) and the International Journal of Applied Power Engineering (IJAPE). His notable works include:

Beyond academics, he has led several community development initiatives.

Sri Dey considers his award a recognition of his belief that teaching should inspire curiosity and extend learning beyond the classroom—shaping not only skilled professionals but also responsible citizens.

Sri. Ashim Kumar Mukhopadhyay, Supervisor (Machinist) at Government ITI Durgapur, has over 24 years of experience in technical education. His career began as an Operator Machinist at TATA Timken Limited in 1992, but his passion for teaching and nurturing talent led him to join as an Instructor in the Machinist trade in March 2001. Since then, he has trained more than 300 trainees, many of whom are now employed in prestigious organizations such as Indian Railways, Defence Research and Development Organisation, Durgapur Steel Plant (Steel Authority of India Limited), Indian Iron & Steel Company Burnpur (Steel Authority of India Limited), Bokaro Steel Plant (Steel Authority of India Limited), Geological Survey of India, Ordnance Factories, Garden Reach Shipbuilders & Engineers, TATA Motors, and Larsen & Toubro Limited. His students have also excelled in national competitions, including securing top positions in All India Trade Test and Skill Competitions. 
